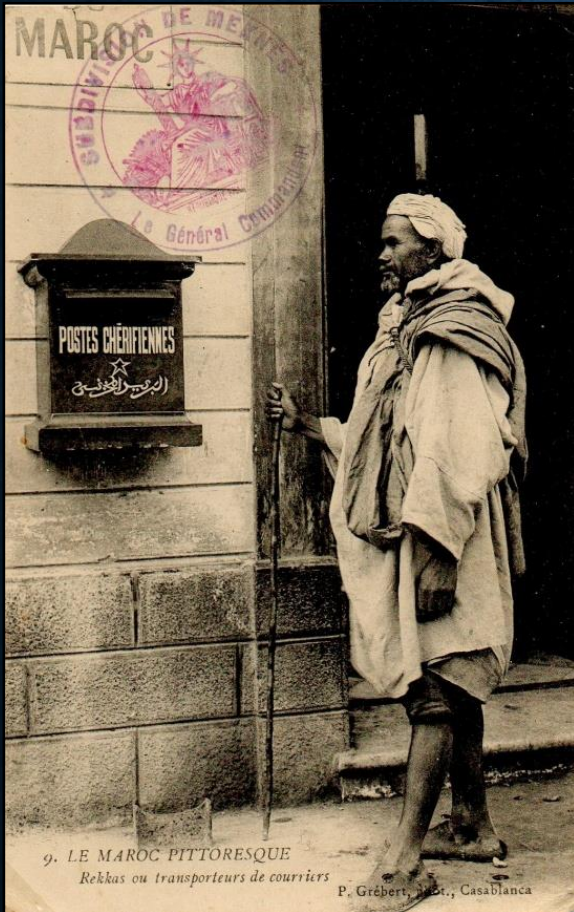

**LOCAL POST – not yet in the UPU system**

with its palm tree



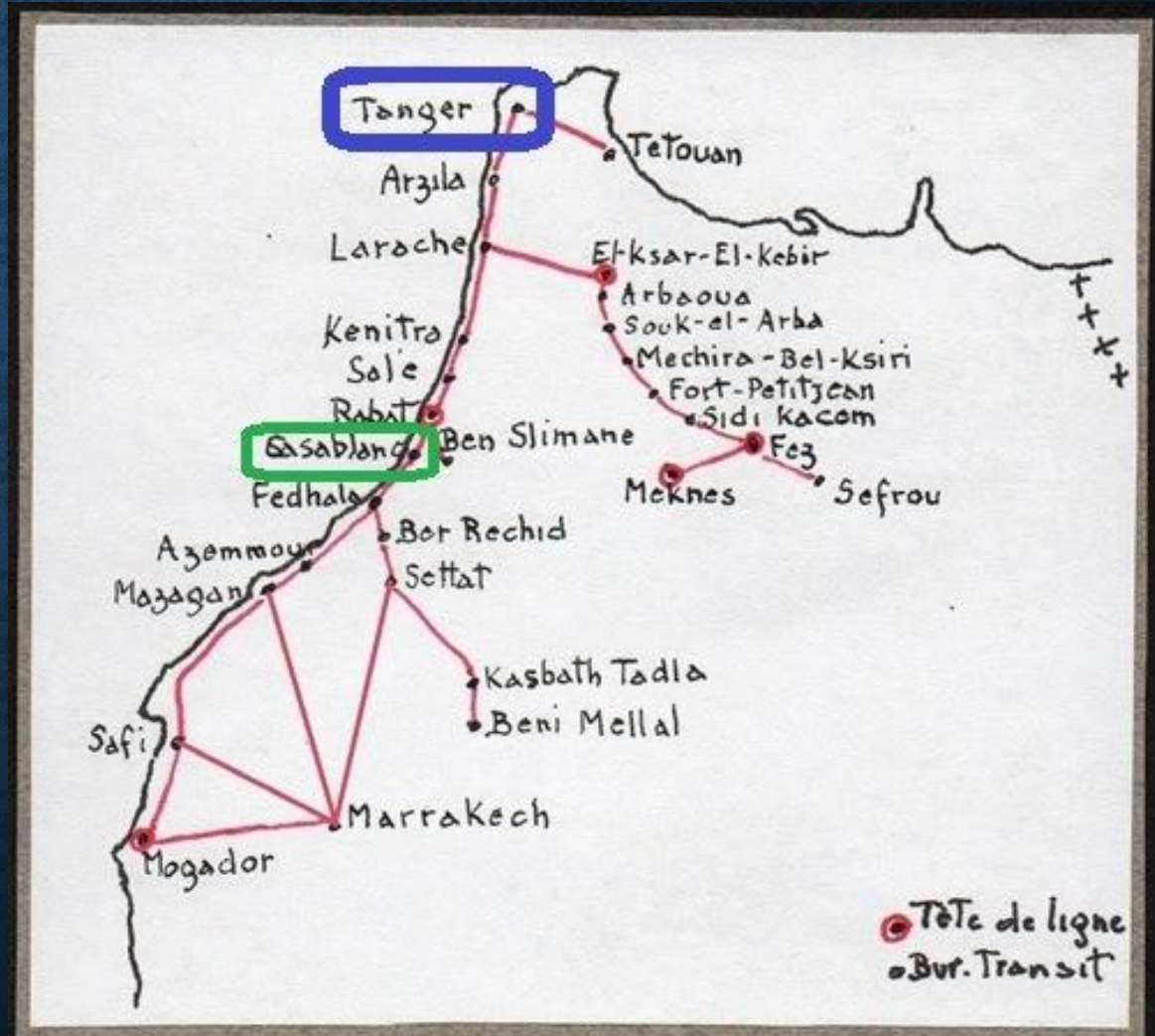

# MIXED FRANKING - SHERIFIAN + FR

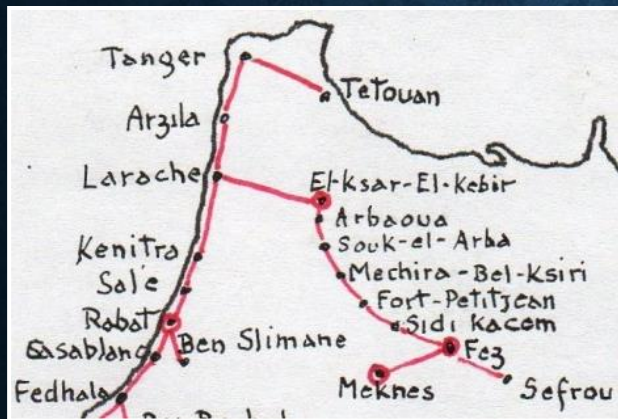
Cover from Fes to Tangier and then to France

Sherifian – domestic rate at 10m

French Post – rate to France = 10 centimos

Both frankings have been applied by the sender

Via TANGIER

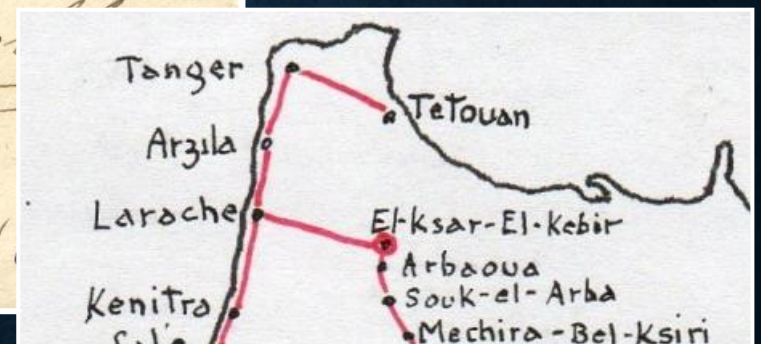




Registered cover from Arbaoua to Tanger and then to France  
Sherifian – domestic rate at 10m + 25m (registration)  
French Post – rate to France at 10c + 25 centimos

over it.



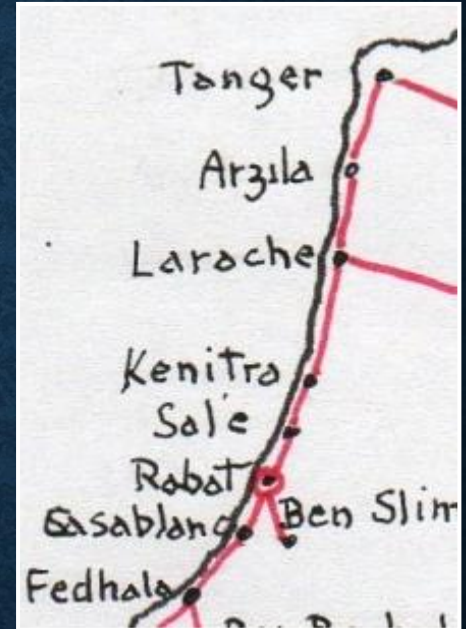




Cover from Meknes to Tangier and then to Denmark

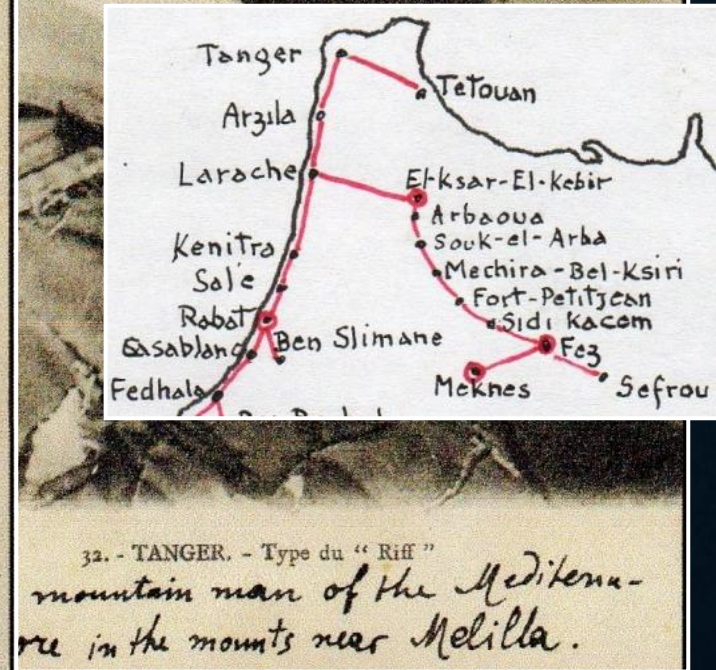
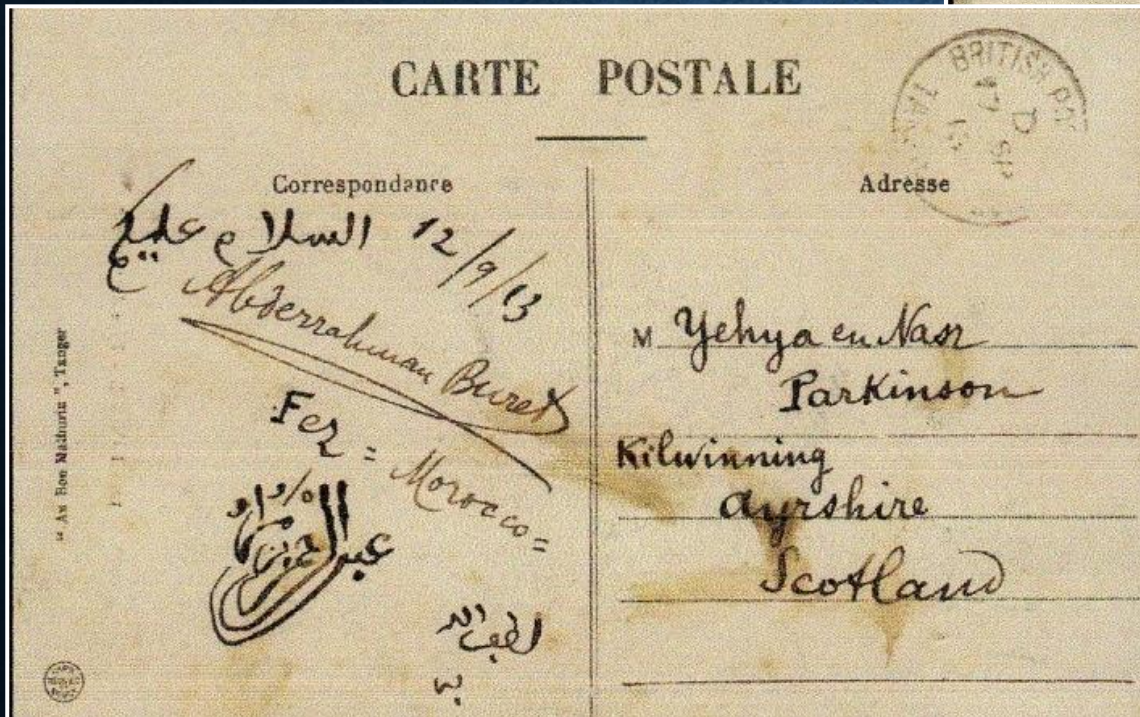
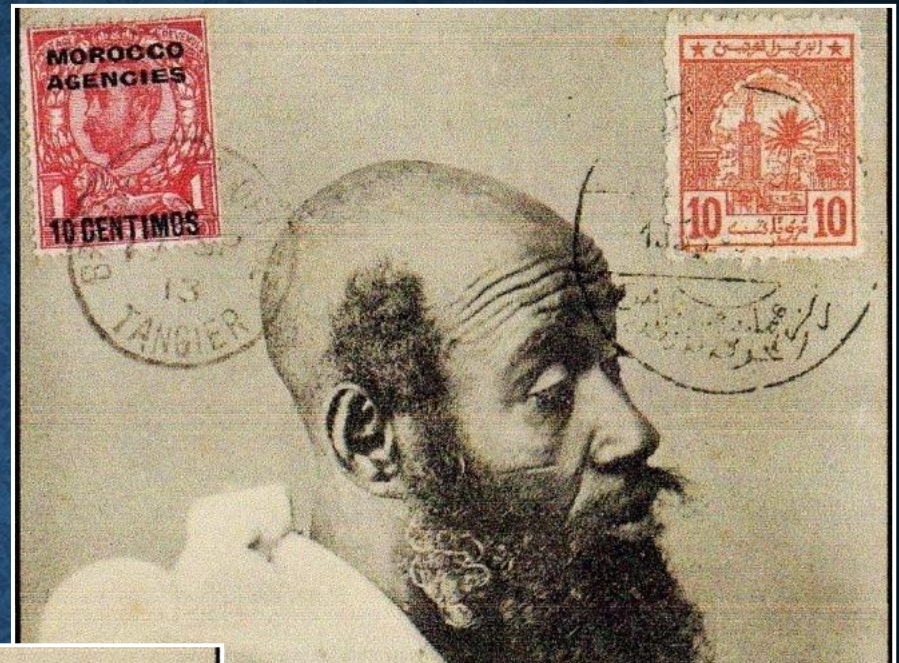


Registered cover from Fedhala to Casablanca and then to France

10 centimos



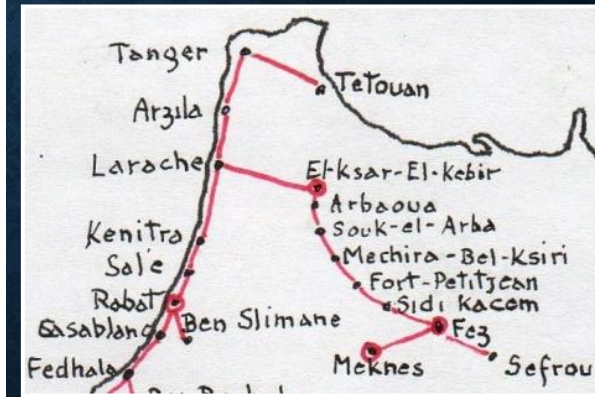


# MIXED FRANKING SHERIFIAN + SPANISH

Inland registered cover to Tangier and then to Spain  
Sherifian – domestic rate at 10m/20gr + 5m/20gr add. (3x)+ 25m (registration)  
+ Spanish Post – rate to Spain at 10 c/30gr + 10c/30g add. (2x)+ 25 centimos

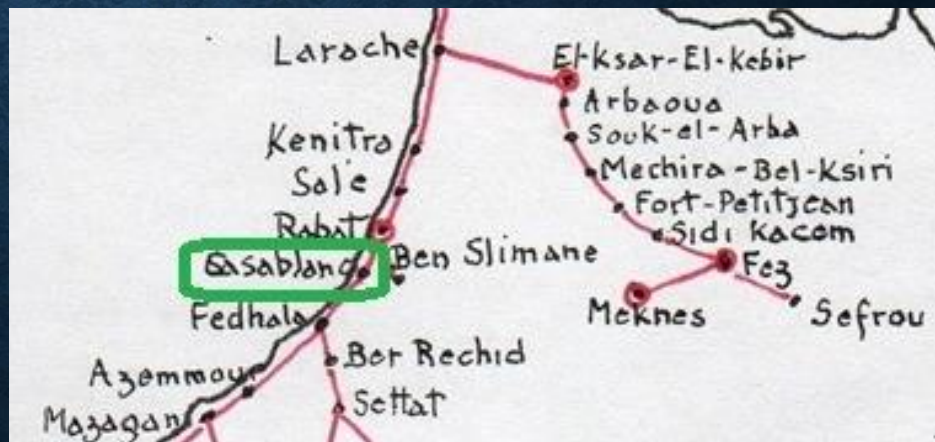


# MIXED FRANKING ??? SHERIFIAN + GERMAN

and then forwarded  
From Casablanca to Mazagan with

German stamps applied over the  
sherifian cancel of Fes

Sherifian domestic rate = 10m  
German domestic rate =  
10 centimos
