





Registered cover from Boma December 27th, 1932 (5 days before the end of Mols use = 31.12.1932)

to Costermansville (3rd Feb 1933) via Leo, Bukama & Albertville  $2^{nd}$  domestic rate = 1.25 F + 0.75F + 2 F(registration) = 4 F Franked by 1F & 3F overprinted 1921 – Boma type 7 on Mols.
