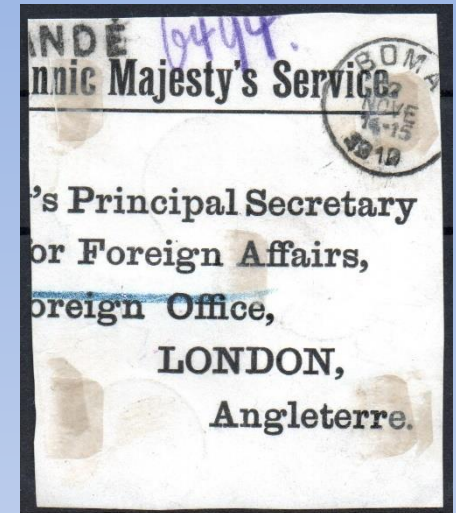

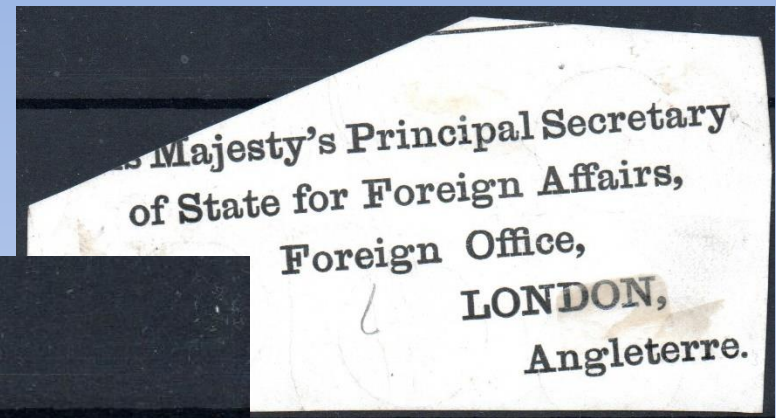

32th rate (75c + 31x 40c/20gr) + 75c registr = 13,90 Fr

Franked at 14 Fr by 1F Bilingual 1915 + 10F with 1921 overprint + 3F Vloors

Part of registered cover (reinforced) sent from Elisabethville on 12 March 1926.

64th rate (1F + 63x 60c/20gr) + 1F registr = 39,80 Fr

Franked at 40 Fr by a block of 4 of 10F with 1921 overprint

1931



Tshikapa 9 Feb. 1931 – small packet
label in registered to Belgium.

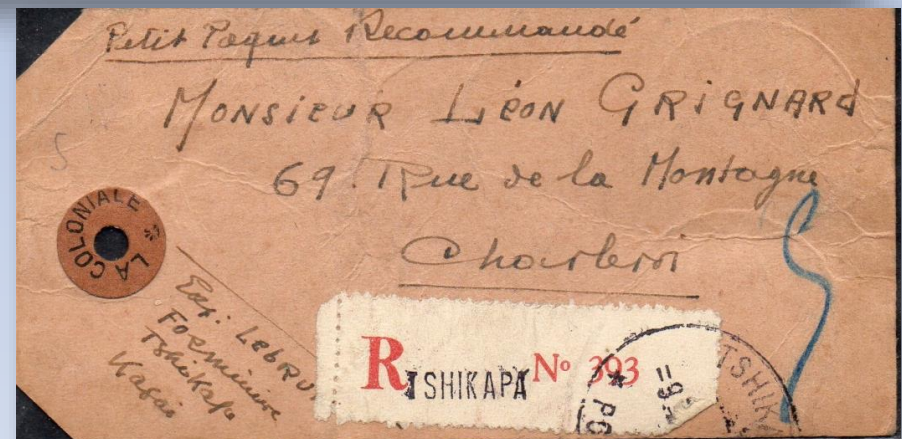

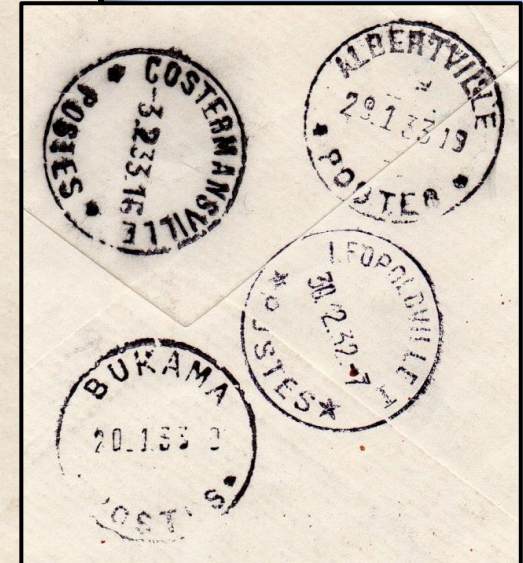

1932



Registered cover from Boma December 27th, 1932

(5 days before the end of Mols use = 31.12.1932)

to Costermansville (3rd Feb 1933) via Leo, Bukama & Albertville

2nd domestic rate = 1.25 F + 0.75F + 2 F(registration) = 4 F

Franked by 1F & 3F overprinted 1921 – Boma type 7 on Mols.
